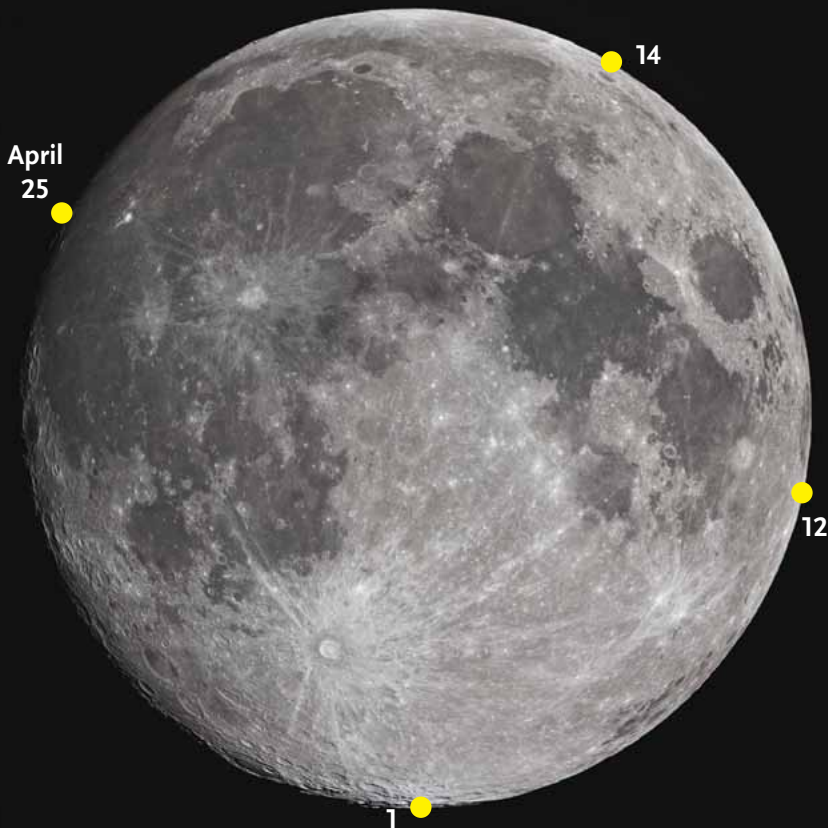


The Moon • April 2013
