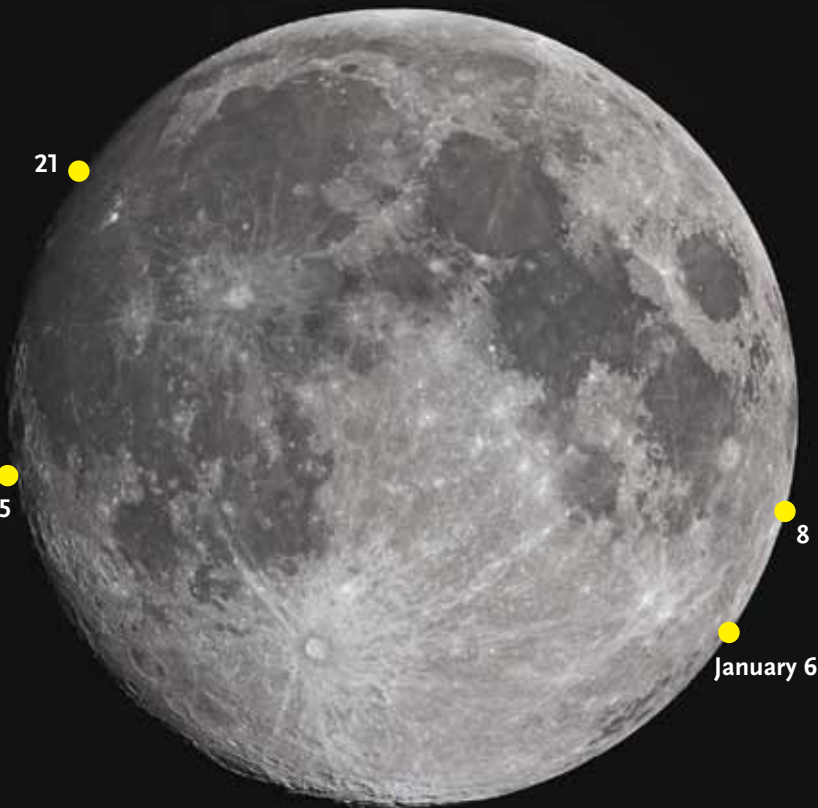


# The Moon • January 2014
