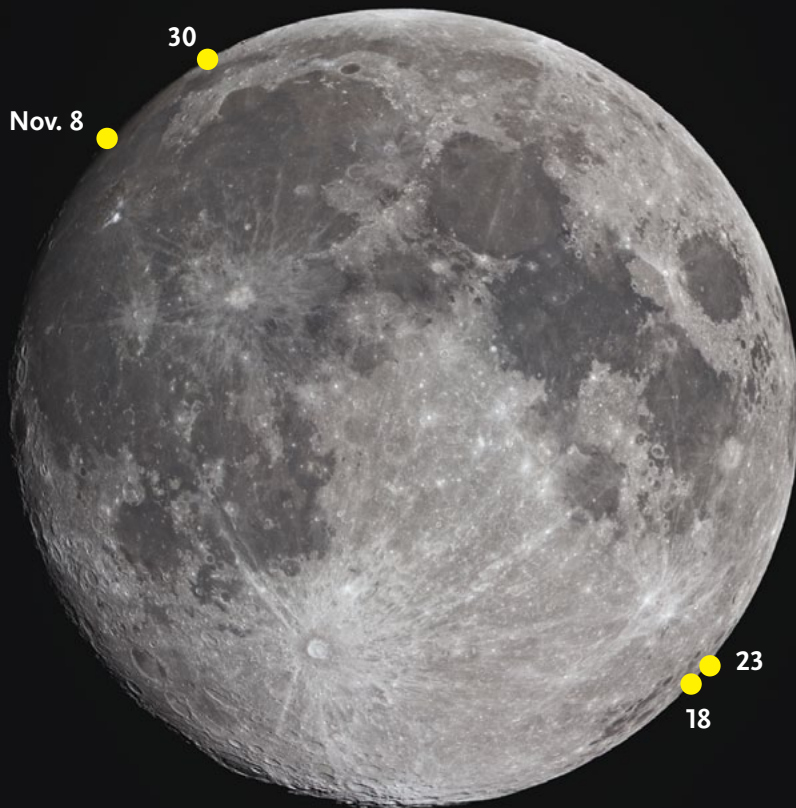




For key dates, yellow dots indicate what part of the Moon's limb is tipped the most toward Earth by libration under favorable illumination.
